## About the course:

This qualification reflects the role of support workers who complete specialised tasks and functions in aged care services; either in residential, home or community based environments. Workers will take responsibility for their own outputs within defined organisation guidelines and maintain quality service delivery through the development, facilitation and review of individualised service planning and delivery.

To achieve this qualification students must have completed at least 120 hours of direct support work at a care facility.

## Delivery Mode:

Classroom Training, Online Training and Work Based Training. All programs include self-directed learning.

## Entry Requirements:

To be eligible for this course the enrolling student will need to be willing to obtain a National Police Check, Working with Childrens Check or equivalent as per state requirement, along with a NDIS Workers Screening Check. Students must have access to a computer, stable internet connection and a working microphone and camera (online programs only).

## How long will my training program run?

All students have up to 24 months to complete their qualification. Specific course schedules will be provided prior to enrolment for each program.
